ICM has been designated as the official donations management organization for the City of League City and for Galveston County. To facilitate this they are setting up a distribution center in the former Palais Royale location in the old HEB shopping center at 518 and Hwy 3 in League City. The place will open to receive donations starting Monday.

They can use donations of the following items: Canned goods, diapers, baby goods, feminine supplies, clothes, shoes, kitchen stuff, pillows, linens. They ask that clothes be brought on hangars wherever possible. They could probably use some volunteers to help sort and set up racks.

This location is not a FEMA POD (Point of Distribution). They won't have ice and such.
